The Civic Volunteers under West Bengal Police and Kolkata Police and Village Police Volunteers under West Bengal Police are entitled to the Terminal Benefit @ Rs. 3,00,000/- (Three Lakh) with effect from 08.09.2020 vide this Department G.O. No. 1637(2)-PL/PB/14M-37/2020 dated 16.09.2020, and the eligibility for granting such benefit in favour of a Civic Volunteer / Village Police Volunteer has been stated in this Department G.O. No. 3082(2)-PL/PB/14M-56/2021 dated 24.12.2021. A proposal for upward revision of the terminal benefit was under active consideration of the Government for some time past.
